### ❖ 40 DAYS FOR LIFE IS BACK *THIS FALL NOW* WITH TWO LOCATIONS!

Looking forward to the next coordinated 40 Days for Life campaign? **Then mark your calendar for September 23 — November 1, 2009.**

This mission of love has not only saved the lives of thousands (over 1,561), but it has also mobilized over 215,000 people in over 240 cities throughout North America, Australia and Ireland. We anticipate that this campaign, with your help, will have an even more profound impact on the lives of even more women in crisis.

This fall Toronto will be uniting with dozens of other cities across North America – and around the world – for the largest and longest coordinated pro-life mobilization in history – the *40 Days for Life* campaign. People of all Christian denominations are praying that this effort will mark the beginning of the end of abortion.

*40 Days for Life* is an inter-denominational focused pro-life campaign that has generated measurable lifesaving results. It has lead to a significant drop in abortions on almost all locations, and in some places to the closing of all abortion clinics. The *40 Days for Life* campaign is made up of three key components:

- **Prayer and Fasting:** inviting people of faith throughout our city to join together for 40 days of fervent prayer and fasting for an end to abortion (This is a spiritual battle, and some demons can only be driven out by prayer & fasting)
- **Peaceful Vigil:** standing for life through a 40-day peaceful public witness outside of an abortion facility.

  - **960 Lawrence Ave West (Dufferin/Lawrence) \*24 hours/day**
  - **NEW LOCATION: Cabbagetown Women's Clinic (Abortion Facility) 302 Gerrard St. East, Toronto (\*7am-5pm)**
- **Community Outreach:** taking a positive, upbeat pro-life message to every corner of our city through media

efforts, church presentations, petition drives, and public visibility

### **40 Days for Life campaign wrap-up for Spring 2009**

On behalf of Campaign Life Coalition and 40 Days for Life, I wish to extend to you our sincere gratitude for your prayers and support throughout the 40 Days for Life Spring campaign that ran February 25<sup>th</sup> through April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009. With your help, Toronto's debut campaign was a huge success which mobilized over 1000 individuals in the area for the Pro-Life cause. Thank you!

At the Toronto (Dufferin/Lawrence) location, people reported that there was a noticeable decrease in numbers entering the abortion facility each week, in particular on Saturdays (typically the most). Women and men who had been suffering in silence because of their past abortions broke their silence for the first time and are now on their journey to healing, more than 95% of people who got involved have *never* done anything active in the pro life movement before the 40 Days for Life Campaign, new friends were made and all denominations came together beautifully to focus on something we all have in common! What a beautiful experience it was!

On May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2009, Pastor Bruce Clemenger, the president of the Evangelical Fellowship of Canada, prayed the following words on Parliament Hill on the occasion of the 12<sup>th</sup> annual National March for Life, which is a prayerful pro life witness that occurs through the streets of downtown Ottawa. Over 12 000 pro-lifers participated this year. "...Give us wisdom to use what you have entrusted to us; Give us strength in our resolve to protect and care for all human life. Give us words of wisdom as we choose life, as we affirm the dignity of all human life, and give us strength as we plea for the protection of unborn children. Give us wisdom, and give us strength, we pray. I ask this in the name of Jesus-and all those who love life say. Amen!"
