The Holy Father's missionary prayer intention

In this age of instant messaging, limitless information, and ever-smarter communication devices, the average person is possibly exposed to hundreds of thousands of words each day. Amidst this vast ocean of words, what chance does God's word have to be heard as long as it remains just another voice in this cacophony of competing voices? And yet as the lives and the faith and hopes of millions of Christians over the centuries have witnessed, God's Word is always infinitely more than just another amalgamation of alphabets and syllables. In a world where words are ephemeral, God's Word is eternal. In a world saturated with information, God's Word effects formation and re-formation. In a world where communication is increasingly impersonal, God's Word is above all personal - finding its fullest expression in a person, the person of Jesus Christ. He is the Alpha and Omega - the first and the final Word of God. He is "the Way, the Truth, and the Life". He is the "mot juste" - the finest and most fitting word - of God for a world that hungers and thirsts for existential meaning.

But this Word, this Promise, this Person can only exercise His power when He is possessed and proclaimed by each of us. As long as Jesus remains a prisoner of print and pages and paper, he remains just another word among the millions we encounter in the course of our lives. But when the Word take flesh within each of us, He gives us the power to become the voice that cries out in the wilderness, the message that goes out to the ends of the earth, the good news that God-is-always-with-us and for us and is us." Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life!"

During this month in which we commemorate another World Mission Day (October 20), may we let ourselves be possessed by the Word of God and be active proclaimers of it, as the Pope expects of us.

* The fullness of God's consolation is so great that the sweetness of it not only touches the soul, but even overflows to the body.
