Letter of Appointment

The people sit. The Bishop sits at the chair and the pastor comes before him. Mr. Attila Zubovits: Your Excellency, we ask you to install Fr. Sajgo, for service as pastor of this church. Bishop Grecco: Have you a letter of appointment? Mr. Attila Zubovits: We have. Bishop Grecco: Let it be read. Mr. Attila Zubovits reads the letter of appointment.

Hymn of Praise (Gloria)

Intonation in Latin by the Bishop, followed by the people in Hungarian

Liturgy of the Word

The First Reading *is in English by Ms. Veronika Zydron.* The Psalm *is in Hungarian by the Youth Choir and the people*: Ne félj, ne aggódj (*R54*). The Second Reading *is in Hungarian by Mr. Mihály Lents.* Alleluia *in Hungarian by the Youth Choir and the people*: Add a kezed (*R89*). The Gospel is in Hungarian by Rev. Szabolcs Sajgó SJ.

Homily

Installation The assembly stands.

THE PROFESSION OF FAITH AND OATH OF FIDELITY ON ASSUMING OFFICE

The pastor stands and, with his right hand on the Book of the Gospels (brought forward and held by Mr. István Bessenyei), makes his profession of faith.

I, Szabolcs Sajgó firmly believe and profess each and everything that is expressed in the Creed, namely: *In the profession of faith the people join the pastor:*

I believe in one God, the Father, the almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen. I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, one in being with the Father. Through Him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation He came down from heaven; by the power of the Holy Spirit, He was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake, He was crucified under Pontius Pilate; He suffered, died and was buried. On the third day He rose again in fulfillment of the Scriptures; He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and His kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son He is worshipped and glorified. He has spoken through the prophets. I believe in the one holy catholic and apostolic Church. I acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. I look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

With firm faith, I believe also all that is contained in the Word of God, whether written or handed down in tradition, which the Church, either in solemn judgement or by its ordinary and universal teaching authority, sets forth for our belief as revealed by God.

I also firmly accept and hold each and everything definitely proposed by the Church concerning its teachings on faith and morals.

Moreover, I adhere with religious submission of intellect and will to the teachings which either the Roman Pontiff or the College of bishops enunciate in the exercise of their authentic teaching authority, even if they do not intend to proclaim those teachings by a definitive act.

On assuming the office of Pastor, promise that both in my words and in my conduct I shall always preserve communion with the Catholic Church.

With great care and faithfulness, I shall carry out the duties, which bind me to the Church, both universal and particular, in which I have been called to serve, according to the requirements of the law.

In fulfilling the charges entrusted to me in the name of the Church, I shall hold fast to the deposit of faith in its entirety. I shall faithfully hand it on and expound it, and I shall avoid any teachings opposed to that faith. I shall follow and foster the discipline common to the whole Church, and I shall observe all ecclesiastical laws, especially those contained in the Code of Canon Law.

I shall follow with Christian obedience what the sacred pastors as authentic doctors and teachers of the faith declare, and what they as rulers of the Church prescribe. I shall also faithfully assist the diocesan bishops, so that the apostolic work to be exercised in the name and by the mandate of the Church be carried out in the communion of the same Church.

So help me God and these His holy Gospels, which I touch with my hand.

The pastor signs both copies of the profession of faith at a suitable place, though not on the altar. The assembly is directed to sit. They remain seated throughout the procession. A short acclamation may be sung as the procession moves from place to place and after the last station.

Procession

The Ministry of Baptism

The Bishop takes the pastor to the baptismal font.

Bishop: Be a faithful minister of holy baptism, so that all who approach the Church in faith, and the children of your parish may be reborn in Christ. Will you instruct them and prepare them for their confirmation and first Eucharist?

- Pastor: With the help of God, I will.

Bishop to the people: Will you present your children for baptism, confirmation and Eucharist and bring them up in the knowledge and love of our Lord Jesus Christ?

- *People:* With the help of God, we will.

The Ministry of Reconciliation

The Bishop takes the pastor to the confessional with open doors.

Bishop: By ordination you have been appointed minister of Christ's reconciliation in the sacrament of reconciliation and in the care of your people. Will you carefully carry out these duties? - *Pastor:* With the help of God, I will.

Bishop to the people: Will you seek reconciliation with Christ in the sacrament of reconciliation and try to bring peace and reconciliation into your lives and to the society in which we live?

- *People:* With the help of God, we will.

The Ministry of Care of the Sick

The priest comes to the ambry.

Bishop: Will you take special care for the sick and the dying, bring to them the healing power of Christ by prayer and the Sacrament of Anointing and offer them the Viaticum of Christ's Body and Blood?

- Pastor: With the help of God, I will.

Bishop to the people: Will you share the ministry to the sick and dying in your homes and in the parish, and summon the priest in case of need?

- *People*: With the help of God, we will.

The Ministry of Preaching and Teaching

At the ambo where the Book of the Gospels is open.

Bishop: This book enshrines the Word of God. Will you regularly meditate upon it and preach it to your people?

- Pastor: With the help of God, I will.

Bishop to the people: Will you follow your pastor in the reading of the Scriptures and model your life on the Word of God day by day?

- People: With the help of God, we will.

Ministry of Prayer

While remaining at the ambo.

Bishop: Will you pray the Liturgy of the Hours

with due attention and devotion, for your people, and with them, as opportunity allows?

- Pastor: With the help of God, I will.

Bishop to the people: Will you regularly pray for your pastor and join in prayer with him as opportunity allows?

- *People:* With the help of God, we will.

The Ministry of the Eucharist

The server places the corporal, chalice and paten on the altar. The Bishop and pastor come to the altar and face the people.

Bishop: The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. It is your duty to preside at the Eucharist to make present Christ's sacrifice. With you, all your people give praise and thanks to God, and are united in love by the Holy Spirit as they partake of the Body and Blood of Christ. Will you gather your people regularly to celebrate this mystery of faith?

- Pastor: With the help of God, I will.

Bishop to the people: Will you participate with your pastor in giving praise and thanks to God in the celebration of the Eucharist?

- *People:* With the help of God, we will.

The Pastoral Office

The Bishop leads the pastor to the presider's chair and seats him there. Then (holding or touching the priest's stole or chausible, if he so wishes):

Bishop: Recall that the stole (and chausible) given you at ordination is a symbol of your priestly ministry. See that you generously fulfill your task of serving the people of this parish now entrusted to your care.

- Pastor: Amen

Bishop to the people: I now present to you your pastor.

- People: Thanks be to God.

General Intercessions

Bishop: My brothers and sisters, let us pray with confidence to the God of all mercies for the Church, for this parish and for all our needs.

Mr. Dénes Elekes: For all Church ministers and lay helpers, that they may seek the glory of God and draw all people into his kingdom. We pray to the Lord.

Mr. Zsolt Csiszér: Imádkozzunk, hogy egyházaink egyesüljenek a hitben, szeretetben és az imádásban Isten asztalánál. Könyörögjünk az Úrhoz.

Miss Brigitta Pulins: For Pope N, Bishop N and the bishops of our Church, that they may continue the mission entrusted by Jesus to the Twelve: We pray to the Lord.

Bishop: Direct our actions, Lord, by your inspiration, and support them by your aid, that every prayer and work may begin with your grace and be completed in your service. Grant this through Christ our Lord. *All:* Amen.
