Renee Hanna Anton was born in Toronto in 2003. Her parents are music teachers, therefore, Renee was surrounded with music ever since her birth. She started playing the violin at the age of 4, and by age 6 Renee was a member of the Brampton Symphony Youth Orchestra. Renee studied with David Zafer before moving to Germany for two years, where she studied at the Cologne University's pre-academy violin program. At age nine, Renee returned to Toronto and continued her musical studies at the Taylor Academy for Young Artists of the Royal Conservatory of Music. She is currently studying with Atis Bankas. In the Canadian Music Competition (Quebec, 2014) she achieved 2nd place in her category with 95%. In May 2015 she received 1st Place in the Kocian International Violin Competition (Czech Republic) in her category (age 11-12). She was a member of the Bach Children Chorus, the Toronto Children's Chorus, and currently sings with the Young Voices of Toronto Choir.
